Rubber Bridge:

winning the rubber 2-0 : 700
winning the rubber 2-1 : 500
game in an unfinished rubber : 300

Chicago & Duplicate:

bonus for partscore : 50
bonus for non-vulnerable game : 300
bonus for vulnerable game : 500

Rubber & Chicago:

4/5 trump honours in one hand : 100
5/5 trump honours in one hand : 150
four aces in one hand in NTs : 150

Examples



Assume you and your opponents play four hands of Bridge.

- (1) They deal first, bid 3♠ and make an overtrick
- (2) We deal, bid 4♥ doubled and make an overtrick
- (3) They bid 5♦ doubled and fail by four tricks
- (4) They bid 1NT redoubled and fail by a trick

Rubber Bridge

| 240 (2) | | 90 (1) |

- (1) 3 x 30 (tricks bid and made) + 30 (overtrick)
- (2) 4 x 60 (tricks bid and made doubled) + 50 (insult) + 100 (dbld overtrick)
- (3) Four down dbld non-vul = 1100
- (4) One down redbld vul = 400
- (*) You score 300 for game in an unfinished rubber.

Total difference in points: 1690 - 120 = 1570
 Rounded to the nearest hundred (fifty rounds down): **+16**

Chicago

(NB: playing part-scores do not carry over - as per Friday night)

- (1) 3 x 30 + 30 + 50 (partscore)
- (2) 4 x 60 + 200 (vul dbld overtrick) + 50 (Insult) + 500 (vul game)
- (3) Four down dbld vul = 1100
- (4) One down redbld vul = 400

Duplicate

Duplicate scores are calculated in the same way as Chicago - easy as that!
